Study Abroad Ambassadors are a volunteer organization of Mercer students, who after their return from a study abroad program, commit to become student leaders on-campus through outreach and promotion of Mercer's study abroad opportunities.

Responsibilities:

Able to assist the Office of International Programs on a volunteer basis for at least 2 hours/week. Able to support at least two study abroad events during the semester (excluding events occurring during Study Abroad Week).

• Professionalism:

Commit to following university and office protocol regarding standards, policy, and procedure.

• Interest:

Passionate about contributing to an increasingly global society.
